Admissions to The Rolf Institute®

 An official academic transcript showing at least 60 credit hours at an institution of higher education.

OR

A High School diploma or equivalent AND

Official documentation verifying equivalent coursework and success in an adult education program.

Please note: AFORSI students may use their massage school transcript to satisfy the requirement for equivalent adult education coursework.

- Submission of a written 2-3 page personal life experience essay. Please contact the Admissions Advisor for the essay questions and requirements.
- Completion and approval of an application and required enrollment forms.
- Submission of a resume and solo headshot photograph (for identification purposes).
- Verification of having received at least three sessions of the Rolfing Ten-Series from a Certified Rolfer.
- \$50 Application fee. (Fee will be refunded if student is not admitted or has not signed an enrollment agreement.)
- Completion of a minimum 250-hour bodywork program. Students must submit an official transcript that shows at least 47 hours of Anatomy, 21 hours of Physiology, 45 hours of Massage or other approved touch training, and 15 hours of Therapeutic Relationship.
- 50 documented hours of postgraduate massage practice experience or comparable clinical experience.

Written assignments are due 2 weeks before Accelerated Foundations begins.

Phase I: Accelerated Foundations of Rolfing Structural Integration

87 hours ~ Two weeks ~ \$1,785 + fees

There is no requirement for a

study interval between Accelerated Foundations of Rolfing Structural Integration and Embodiment of Rolfing SI & Rolf Movement[®] Integration.

Prior to Embodiment of Rolfing SI & Rolf Movement Integration:

- Verification of having received the Rolfing Ten-Series from a Certified Rolfer™ at least six months prior.
- Verification of having received five Rolf Movement Integration sessions from a Certified Rolf Movement Practitioner.

Written assignments are due 4 weeks before Embodiment of Rolfing SI & Rolf Movement Integration begins.

Phase II: Embodiment of Rolfing Structural Integration & Rolf Movement Integration

244 hours ~ Eight weeks ~ \$6,851 + fees

A three-month study interval is required between Embodiment of Rolfing SI & Rolf Movement Integration and Clinical Application of Rolfing Theory.

A mentorship with a Rolfer for supervision and practice of skills is highly recommended during the study interval between Embodiment of Rolfing SI & Rolf Movement Integration and Advanced Rolfing Certification Program.

Written assignments are due 4 weeks before Clinical Application of Rolfing Theory begins.

Phase III: Clinical Application of Rolfing Theory

Required Continuing Education
